The Airplane Factory (TAF) is a Johannesburg based company which designs, manufactures and sells light sport airplanes and construction kits. The Sling 2, a two-seater light sport aircraft, was launched in 2009 when TAF directors Mike Blyth and James Pitman built the prototype and flew around the globe in it – breaking numerous aviation records in the process.

Following the worldwide success of the Sling 2, TAF developed a 4-seater, available as a taildragger (Sling 4) and a soon-to-be released Sling TSi. The Sling TSi, like its predecessors, has received critical acclaim for its effortless handling and all-round functionality. The name 'TSi' is a homage to its Rotax 915 turbo sports injected engine and marks a new chapters in TAF's vision to build the world's most loved light aircraft.
