A first for Africa, the Tshwane Interactive Digital Centre (IDC) is a partnership between the City of Tshwane and EON Reality Inc, a global company that leads the VR/AR market worldwide.

By facilitating easy access to virtual reality and augmented reality (VR/AR) solutions, the IDC is supporting the City's transition to a smart city and its socio-economic growth objectives.

Opening in 2016, the IDC has three areas:

1. Innovation Academy: accepts 50 students per year, many from disadvantaged backgrounds
2. Development Studio: harnesses these new skillsets to create new (and locally relevant) VR/AR content
3. Showroom: showcases state

Education and vocational training

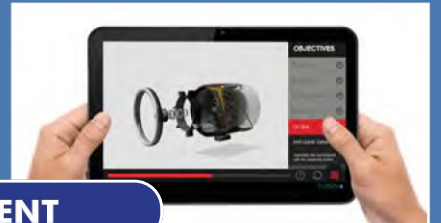
VR/AR solutions transforms STEM education and accelerates vocational skills development.
